We are fortunate that we have been able to leverage the successful remote learning experience we had for the last term using our exclusive educational technologies, delivering quality virtual learning material to our students and supporting them in achieving the best results in the end of year assessments.

LEARNING FOR NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR- SCHOOL DAY

We have our students' best interests at the heart. Hence, we have worked on a detailed plan for the blended learning scenario to combine the best of face to face and remote learning approaches for an optimised outcome on our students' educational experience. However, we are fully ready for any other scenario subject to health and safety measures, and direction from authorities.

BLENDED LEARNING

Students of Pre-School to Year9

Students will be split into 2 groups where only 50% of students attending face to face classes in a day, maintaining the appropriate social distancing measures- Maximum 13 students. Each group will attend on alternate day rotation. The mix of face to face physical attendance at school, with the enhanced remote learning will ensure the coverage of all subjects as well as written materials, assignments, enrichment programmes and activities.

FULL RETURN TO SCHOOL

We have already started a full programme of summer works in both schools. Our campuses are now in the best shape to receive our students, staff and parents. Children from **Pre-School to Year12** will attend at school on a normal school day with enhanced student life at the highest health and safety measures in place.

FULL REMOTE LEARNING

In the unlikely event, that all schools are instructed by the Ministry of Education to maintain full remote -learning at the start of, or at any time during the course of, the next academic year, we are ready to implement our enhanced remote -learning model (as outlined in the blended scenario), with full live lessons for all students from pre-school to Year 12, based upon our normal school day schedule.




